2026 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This is the 11th consecutive year that the Ogemaw Hills Snowmobile Club (OHSC) is offering a scholarship. This year we are pleased to announce we will be donating a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating high school senior from West Branch-Rose City Area Schools who have the following:

- 1. Have an interest in snowmobiling or ORVing as a recreational activity
- 2. Plans to further their education in an accredited university, state college, technical or trade school. This does NOT have to be related to snowmobiling or ORVing
- 3. GPA of 2.0 or "C" average

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 Include a photo of You (**Preferably** your Senior Picture) and a Photo of you and your snowmobile, **if you have one**. This **is not required** but encouraged.
- 2 One letter of recommendation from a School Administrator, Teacher, Counselor, Coach or Employer. (Only one letter needed)
- 3 Be available for a scholarship presentation at the OHSC clubhouse Fairview Rd. West Branch, MI

Scholarships will be given to the selected student regardless of other grants or scholarships that the student may also receive.

Note: The OHSC Scholarship Award will be in the form of a check sent directly to your school of choice with your student account number for the Fall term. You must be able to provide your Student Number. *Non-attendance at the program will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
