Child Find

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) that requires states to identify, locate, and evaluate all children with disabilities who are in need of early intervention or special education services. To receive Early Intervention Programming or Special Education, children must meet eligibility guidelines according to the IDEA. If you suspect you have a child who may have a disability affecting them, please notify your child's teacher, counselor or principal (if they are in school), or the Special Services office at 989-343-2010.

If your child is age birth to 3 years of age and you are concerned with their development, please reach out to COOR ISD Early On services coordinator Michele Cochrane at 989-275-9537.

COOR ISD Early On provides free early intervention services for infants and toddlers, birth to three years of age, with developmental delay(s) and/or disabilities. COOR ISD Early On also supports parents and families so that they can address the unique needs of their eligible infants and toddlers and enhance their health, development, and learning.
